## **Reception Class Admissions - September 2021**

On-line applications for primary school has now opened. The closing date for applications is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020. The best way to apply is online at <a href="https://www.staffordshire.gov.uk/Admissions">https://www.staffordshire.gov.uk/Admissions</a>. If your child's 5th birthday is between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022 then you will need to apply for a place at First, Infant or Primary School.
