Our main method of communication is via the School Jotter app. To ensure you get any messages it is important that you download the school app (School Jotter) to your smartphone/tablet and create your login. If you have not yet set up your log-in you can do so by following the 'How to Download and Create a Password on School Jotter/Website' instructions on the school website.

ParentPay

Parents are reminded that school lunches need to be pre-booked on ParentPay before 8 am on the day required. If a meal has not been booked, it will be expected that children bring a packed lunch from home.

Rainbows provides a safe setting in school in which children can talk through their feelings with their peers who are experiencing similar situations.
