https://www.staffordshire.gov.uk/Admissions. If your child's 5th birthday is between 1st September 2022 and 31st August 2023 then you will need to apply for a place at First, Infant or Primary School.

Communication with parents – School app login

Our main method of communication is via the School Jotter app. To ensure you get any messages it is important that you download the school app (School Jotter) to your smartphone/tablet and create your login. If you have not yet set up your log-in you can do so by following the '<u>How to Download and Create a Password</u> <u>on School Jotter/Website</u>' instructions on the school website.

<u>Rainbows</u>
