# Predicted Heatwave - 18th-19th July

As I am sure that you are aware, it is going to be extremely hot on Monday and Tuesday next week. The Department of Education (DfE), have released the following guidance:

The Department of Health and Social Care recommends children should not take part in vigorous physical activity on very hot days. Children should wear loose clothing to help keep cool and sunhats with wide brims and should stay in the shade as much as possible. Sunscreen should be used to protect skin and children should be provided with plenty of water."

They have also said that they are not advising schools to close.

Children do not need to wear school uniform. We suggest that they come to school wearing the lightest clothing possible! Please remember to apply sun cream before school, and for children to bring a hat and water bottle. We will not be doing any PE lessons next week and will be making sensible decisions about how long the children will be outside at break and lunchtimes.

We have been on a shopping spree today to ensure we have plenty of air coolers and the Y5/Y6 classrooms will have air conditioning. Class teachers will ensure that their classrooms are as cool as possible.
